It is strange to be writing to you in November and not mentioning dates for Carol Services, Nativities, Christmas Fairs etc. Obviously this term is going to be different from normal but rest assured that we will be doing all we can to make the next seven weeks as enjoyable and as festive as possible.

Pick Up Times and Traffic

We are facing a very challenging situation with traffic at Key Stage Two pick up. As you are no doubt aware, the car park at the park on Cootehall Road is closed and is likely to remain closed for some time. This further restricts the amount of parking available to us. To attempt to alleviate this problem, from **Monday 9**th **November, P6 and P7 pick up time will move to 3:00pm.** I would ask all parents to please;

- If you are in the first pick up time (P4/5), and have no older siblings to wait for, please leave the area as quickly as possible. Not only will this will free up space for the second pick-up time, it is also in line with recent comments from the Minister of Education regarding discouraging parents from congregating at school gates.
- If you are in the second pick up time, please do not arrive at the first pick up time. I know this is challenging as you may be worried about securing a parking space, but, if P4/5 are dismissed at 2:45pm and those parents leave the area promptly, there should be available spaces by 2:55pm.
- Please park with consideration for local residents and other drivers. Do not park on yellow lines, across driveways or in a way that prevents traffic flow.

I appreciate the difficulties for both parents and local residents and will be keeping this issue under review as we move through this term.

Social Distancing at Pick Up Time

Please ensure that you are adhering to social distancing measures at all times on school grounds. Any younger children should be kept at your side. Please enter the playground by the top gate and leave by the bottom gate.
